



San Juan Worm

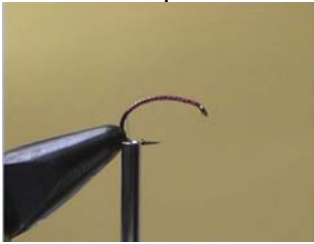
Hook: Daiichi 1120

Thread: 3/0 Red

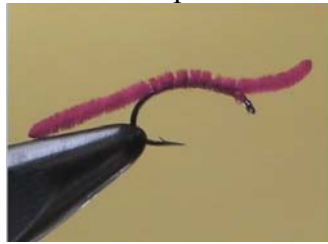
Body: Red Medium Chenille

1. Tie in thread beginning at the eye all the way back to the bend in the hook.
2. Cut chenille to size and tie onto hook to the eye then cut and whip finish.
3. Using a lighter round ends.
4. Go fishing! It's a great winter fly for trout, and it works on bluegill and smallmouth bass also.

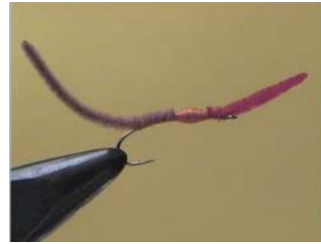

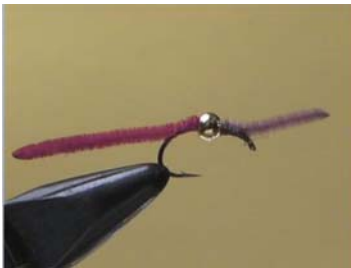
