



### Schmidt's Caddis

**Hook:** Daiichi 1120 Size 10-16

**Thread:** 8/0 Chartreuse

**Rib:** Cooper Wire

**Body:** Chartreuse Chenille

**Head:** Peacock Herl

1. Tie in thread beginning at the eye down the shank to the bend of the hook.
2. Tie in cooper wire and chartreuse chenille.
3. Wrap chenille two-thirds up the shank cut and tie down.
4. Rib the cooper wire up to the chenille cut and tie down.
5. Tie in 3-4 strands of peacock herl and wrap to the hook eye tie down and cut excess.
6. Whip finish and cement. This is a great spring steelhead fly.
