BWO Nymph

Hook: Daiichi 1530 Size 12-16

Thread: 8/0 Olive

Tail: Lemon Wood Duck Flank Fibers

Rib: Cooper Wire

Body: Olive Rabbit Fur Dubbing

Wingcase: Goose Wing Quill Fibers **Thorax:** Olive Rabbit Fur Dubbing Legs: Brown Partridge Fibers **Bead Head:** 1/8 Spirit River B/H

- 1. Put on the bead head place in the vice and tie in.
- 2. Pull a bunch of lemon wood duck fibers and tie onto the bend of the hook for the tail.
- 3. Tie in a piece of cooper wire.
- 4. Dub in the abdomen with olive rabbit fur dubbing, go half way up the shank between the bend of the hook and the bead head.
- 5. Rib the cooper wire over the abdomen, tie in and cut.
- 6. Tie in a strip of goose wing quill fibers, for the wingcase.
- 7. Dub in the thorax using rabbit fur dubbing making it twice as large as the abdomen.
- 8. Pull wingcase over the thorax tie off at the bead and cut off excess wingcase material.
- 9. Using brown partridge fibers tie in under the thorax for legs. Tie in and cut off excess.
