## DARK GREEN CADDIS LARVA NYMPH



## Recipe

Hook......Scud or Nymph, size 10 – 14

Thread.....Olive 6/0 or 8/0

Weight......Lead wire .015 (Optional)
Abdomen...Bright Green Antron Dubbing

Thorax.....Peacock Herl

Collar.....Brown or Black Hen Saddle Dubbing.... Any Coarse Brown Dubbing

Head.....Thread

- 1. Debarb the hook and place it in your vise.
- 2. Tie-in the thread a the mid-point of the shank and wrap it half way down the hook bend. (Wrap only to the beginning of the hook bend if using a nymph hook.)
- 3. Pinch dub the thread with the bright green dubbing and wrap the dubbed thread 2/3's of the way up the hook shank forming a tapered body that is fatter toward the hook eye. Remove any excess dubbing and let the thread hang.
- 4. Select 2-3 peacock herls, trim off the butt ends, and tie them in tight against the end of the dubbed body. Move the thread forward to within 2-3 hook eye widths of the hook eye and let it hang. Now take the peacock herls and wrap a peacock thorax up to where you left the thread. Tie off and remove the excess herl. Move the thread to just behind the hook eye.
- 5. Select and prepare a hen saddle hackle, tie it in by its tip, and wrap it soft hackle style for 2-3 turns. Tie it off and remove the excess hackle.
- 6. Dub the thread with brown dubbing and make 2 turns tight in front of and against the hackle, then remove any excess dubbing and form a thread head, whip finish, and cut the thread.
- 7. Apply head cement, if desired.
