MIKE'S HONEY ANT



Recipe

HookDry, size 14-16 1XL
ThreadOlive Brown 6/0
AbdomenSow Scud dubbing, Copper
LegsFlashabou Accent, Copper
WingAntron, Dark Dun
ThoraxOpossum Dubbing, Rusty Brown

- 1. Place the hook in the vise, then tie-in the thread in the middle of the hook shank and wrap a thread base back to the hook bend.
- 2. Dub the thread thinly and wrap a football shaped abdomen between the hook bend and slightly behind the middle of the hook shank, then wrap the thread forward to the middle of the hook shank. (You should now have a small empty thread covered hook shank from the middle of the hook shank back to the front of the abdomen.)
- 3. Cut 3 strands of flash legging material and tie them in on top of the hook shank by their middle with x-wraps of thread at the middle of the hook shank. The flash "legs" should now be perpendicular to the hook shank. **DO NOT TRIM THE "LEGS".**
- 4. Cut a 2" piece of Antron and tie it in by one end on top of the hook shank in front of the legs as a wing. The length of the Antron should extend back over the hook bend. Wrap tight thread wraps over the butt ends of the Antron forward to behind the hook eye *(ensure no Antron butts extend over the hook eye)*. **DO NOT TRIM THE WING**.
- 5. Thinly dub the thread and wrap a small ball shaped thorax between the front of the wing and the back of the hook eye. Tie off the dubbing behind the hook eye, do a whip finish, and cut the thread.
- 6. Sweep the legs and wing back past the rear of the hook and trim them even with the **rear** of the hook bend
