## WINTER BLACK STONEFLY



## <u>Recipe</u>

Hook......Long Shank Dry or Emerger, size 12 - 16 Thread.....Black 8/0 Tail......Moose Body Fibers Body......Fine and Dry Black Dubbing Wing......Black Cock Hackle Tip Hackle.....Black Cock Hackle

- 1. Flatten the barb on hook and put it in your vise. Tie-in the thread behind the hook eye and wrap it back to the start of the hook bend, laying down a good thread base.
- 2. Select two moose hairs and tie them in as a tail. The tail should be the length of the hook shank.
- 3. Lightly dub the thread and wrap it back toward the hook eye covering a little more than 2/3 of the hook shank and forming a slim body. Remove excess dubbing.
- 4. Tie-in a single black hackle tip at the end of the dubbed body to form a wing. The hackle tip should be on top of the hook shank and be long enough to just cover the tail. Trim off excess hackle.
- 5. Apply a little more dubbing to the thread and make a couple of turns right in front of the wing over the wing hackle butt. Remove the excess dubbing.
- 6. Tie in the hackle at the end of the dubbing and make 3-4 tight touching turns to right behind the eye. Tie off the hackle and remove the excess.
- 7. Form a neat small thread head, whip finish, and cut the thread.
