## **WOOLLY BUGGER**





## Recipe

Hook.....Streamer/Nymph, size 2-12

Thread.....Suitable color 6/0 Weight(optional)..Lead wire/bead/cone

Tail......Marabou

Rib (optional).....Fine wire/tinsel

Body.....Chenille

Hackle.....Sized for hook/palmered

Head.....Thread

- 1. Tie-in thread at middle of hook shank and wrap back to bend of hook. (If using optional lead wire, wrap a short length of lead wire forward in tight spiral turns from mid hook shank to approximately 1/8" behind hook eye. Then tie-in thread at hook eye, wrap over lead wire to lightly cover it, then wrap thread back to bend of hook. You may optionally apply cement to lead wire if desired.)
- 2. Select 1-2 marabou feathers and join together. Measure tail to equal hook shank length.
- 3. Holding tail at the point of correct length, tie it in with 3-4 tight turns of thread then wrap thread toward hook eye over butt ends of marabou to about slightly behind hook eye. Trim off butt ends of marabou.
- 4. (If using a rib, tie-in 4-5" length of wire or tinsel at same point you tie-in the tail.)
- 5. Select a hackle feather and tie-in tip first at same point you tied-in tail.
- 6. Cut a 5-6" piece of chenille, clean one end to reveal a short section of core, then tie-in exposed core end at same point you-tied in tail.
- 7. Now wrap chenille in tight turns from butt of tail to one hook eye length behind hook eye. Tie off chenille and let thread hang.
- 8. Palmer the hackle forward in open-spaced turns to end of chenille and tie off. Let thread hang.
- 9. (If using rib, counter-wrap wire/tinsel between hackle ribs up to hook eye and tie off.)
- 10. Form thread head, whip finish, cut thread, and apply head cement.
