This is accomplished by arranging meetings, conferences, competitions, and related educational and social activities for the instruction and enjoyment of our members.

Conservation activities focus on the improvement and maintenance of fishing habitat.

Members

MVFF has over 200 members from Dayton and the surrounding area who are dedicated to enjoying and improving fly fishing. Our doors are always open to new members. You don't have to know anything about fly fishing to join. All you need is an interest and desire to learn. Many friendships and fishing partnerships have developed amongst our members and we are always interested in helping new members enjoy our sport.

Meetings

We meet on the second Monday of every month. Meetings start at 5:30 p.m. with a social hour that is followed by dinner. Winter Meetings (October through April) include local area and renowned speaker series. Our Summer Meetings (May through September) are held outdoors, and include a grilled dinner. The annual MVFF casting competition series is also conducted at our Summer meetings.

Instructional Programs

MVFF offers a variety of fly fishing learning opportunities throughout the year. These events are open to all members and are often free. During January and February, MVFF hosts both beginner and advanced fly tying classes. These classes are free to members and the club provides all materials. Professional guides and nationally known experts conduct additional fly tying and casting clinics throughout the year.

Newsletter

Tightlines, our monthly newsletter, is mailed to all members. Tightlines contains timely information about upcoming events, instructional tidbits, Mad River updates, feature articles by members and much more.

Trips & Outings

Each year several trips and outings are available for MVFF members. These include both club and member sponsored events. For example, MVFF hosts an annual spring outing to the American Electric Power Recreational Area (Ohio Power), in central Ohio, for bluegill and bass fishing, camping and a fantastic fish fry.

October is our large annual salmon fish outing to Pere Marquette River in Baldwin, MI. The salmon trip consists of fantastic fishing and memorable camaraderie. This destination has great lodge accommodations and nearby camping.

Some MVFF members usually arrange steelhead trips of their own, inviting other members to join them. These trips are normally in northern Ohio and Pennsylvania during the spring and fall steelhead season. Weekly, between May and September, the club offers Thursday Night Tease (TNT) to different local waters as a way of introducing fishers to diversified waters. TNT brings old and new members together and introduces them to new and different fishing techniques and species. Foremost, TNT is a great excuse to schedule at least one night weekly to your passion of fly fishing.

Conservation

MVFF participates in several conservation projects every year. In conjunction with other regional fly fishing clubs we have been doing fish habitat restoration projects on the Mad River. These habitat projects have proven quite effective in improving trout fishing on the Mad. We have at least two Mad River clean-up days annually as well. Our work on the Mad is not only important for the preservation and conservation of the river, but also demonstrates to land owners along the river the value of responsible fishing. In turn, these land owners open areas that would otherwise be inaccessible to members. MVFF also works with Trout Unlimited and the Ohio Department of Natural Resources on projects related to improving Ohio streams and fish habitat.

Membership

Annual dues are only \$35.00 for an adult. A youth membership (under 18) is free with a sponsored adult and is good until the youth reaches the age of 18. Youth members must be accompanied by their adult sponsor at club events and meetings. To join, fill out the membership form and mail it in.
