LANCE EGAN'S RAINBOW WARRIOR



Recipe

Hook size 14-22 TMC2457 Caddis pupa, Nymph Hook (a 12 will fish well on the Mad River)

Thread Red UTC 70 or UNI 8/0

Bead Silver Tungsten Bead matched to hook size (sz 12 hook – 2.8 or

3.2mm bead)

Tail Pheasant Tail Center Fibers

Body/Wingcase . Large Pearl Tinsel

Thorax Wapsi Sow Scud Dubbing – Rainbow

- 1. Put the bead on the hook with the slot or larger hole facing the hook point and place it in the vise.
- 2. Start the thread behind the bead, cut the tag, and wrap to the bend of the hook.
- 3. Take 6-8 pheasant tail fibers, measure out about half of a shank length, and tie them in at the bend of the hook with the tips pointing rearward.
- 4. Wrap over the excess pheasant tail up to the bead and then trim the excess at the bead.
- 5. Cut a 4 inch strand of tinsel and tie in behind the bead. Tie over the tinsel until you reach the tail tie in point.
- 6. With touching turns, wrap the thread back up to the bead.
- 7. Begin wrapping the tinsel forward, halfway overlapping the previous wrap until you reach the bead.
- 8. Fold the tinsel rearward towards the hook bend and take a few wraps backwards over the top of it to start the wingcase.
- 9. Create a fine 1 inch dubbing noodle and wrap forward to the bead to create the thorax.
- 10. Pull the leftover tinsel over the top of the dubbed thorax and tie in behind the bead.
- 11. Whip finish to build a red collar.
