## **ZEBRA MIDGE**



**<u>Recipe</u>** (popular variations include black with a purple body and green)

Hook ..... size 16-22 2X short emerger hook

- Bead ...... Silver Brass or Tungsten Bead matched to hook size
- Thread ... UTC 70 or UNI 8/0 (red, black, purple, olive)
- Rib ..... Small Silver Wire
  - 1. Place bead on hook with slot or large hole facing the hook point and place in vise.
  - 2. Start thread behind the bead and trim the tag end.
  - 3. Wrap thread in close touching wraps (flatten thread if possible) down to the hook bend and back forward behind the bead.
  - 4. Cut a 4-inch piece of wire and place one end inside the bead. Take thread wraps over the wire to bind it to the hook.
  - 5. Wrap over the wire backwards to the hook bend.
  - 6. Unwind thread, form a tapered body with the tread, keep it even and smooth.
  - 7. Return the thread to behind the bead.
  - 8. Wrap the wire forward in open spirals until you reach the bead.
  - 9. Take wraps on top of the wire, pull the wire back and wrap in front of it.
  - 10. Helicopter or trim the excess free.
  - 11. Build a small thread collar and whip finish.
